Understanding the Registry Leave Your Current Physician

Step 1: Log into the Medical Marijuana Use Registry <u>https://mmuregistry.flhealth.gov/</u>.

If you do not remember your password, you may reset it yourself by selecting <u>Forgot Password</u> on the Login page. Step 2: Navigate to the "YOUR PROFILE" menu option at the top of the page to view your information.
